



Rub Rail Insert Kit

Thank you for purchasing a Steele Rubber Products Rub Rail Insert Kit.

Your kit includes the following items:

- Tuck Tool
- Rub Rail Insert
- This Instruction Sheet

Recommended additional tools:

- Screwdriver
- · Heavy scissors or knife
- Rubber mallet

Preparation:

Your Steele Rubber Products Rub Rail Insert is made of **100%**, **high quality EPDM rubber**. This means it is designed to last and is easy to install- <u>no pre-heating of the insert is required</u> and when compared to plastics or vinyl, your Rub Rail Insert will not fade, shrink or crack. We guarantee it! *

For easy installation, simply follow these steps:

- 1. Remove the old, worn or damaged rub rail insert.
- 2. Be sure to keep or as necessary, replace, any hardware associated with holding the rub rail insert in place- for example: end caps, stainless screws, etc.
- 3. Clean out the existing rub rail insert track- remove any debris, soil and mold. If caulk was used to help secure the old insert, take the time to remove that, too- it will not be necessary for the installation of your new insert.
- 4. If you are wrapping the entire boat (recommended when replacing the insert), start at one end where there was an end cap.
- 5. Press the insert into place by hand or with the help of the included Tuck Tool. Do not use a sharp edge tool, like a knife or screwdriver, or you may damage the insert. **NOTE: no pre-heating or the use of heating tools are necessary.** Your Steele Rubber Products Rub Rail Insert is designed to be installed easily, with minimal tools and regardless of typical boating temperatures!
- 6. If the original insert had a screw securing the end, you may attach that now.

 No overlap is required your Steele Rubber Products Rub Rail Insert is designed not to shrink.
- 7. Continue to carefully press the insert into the track. **NOTE: again, no heating is required to fit the insert around corners and edges- likewise, 'stretching' the material during installation is not necessary.**
- 8. When finishing the installation, trim the insert flush with the edge of the track. Install the necessary/remaining hardware.

Maintenance tips:

We recommend that you maintain your Steele Rubber Products Rub Rail Insert with just soap and water. No additional cleaners, treatments or coatings are necessary- they will add no additional value to the insert and may actually be detrimental. It's this easy!
